

Ben Wheeler Motorized Barstool Racing Rules 2015
As set forth by the B.W.B.P.S.

1. All vehicles must function as a freestanding Barstool.
2. Vehicle to have a minimum fixed seat height of 29" (Twenty-nine inches)
3. Vehicle to have a maximum width of 32.5" (Thirty two and a half inches)
4. Power Description:

5. Vehicle CANNOT have movable outriggers.
6. Vehicle must be able to navigate both left and right hand turns.
7. Vehicle must have a dead man on/off switch that cuts all the power any time the rider leaves the machine.
8. All Racing Entrants must wear an approved helmet and protective gear of choice while operating/driving a Motorized barstool.
9. Spectators will not be allowed to ride Barstools.
10. All Motorized Barstool operators must have a B.W.B.P.S. Issued Barstool Driving License.
11. Notarized Entry Form/ Liability Release will be required to participate.
12. A running start of ten feet or less will be permitted.

Function Description

You must be able to drive the Motorized Barstool across a door threshold, through Beer Joint door, and up to a bar, both elbows must be able to rest on the bar. Dismount the vehicle and the vehicle must remain standing by itself.

In case the establishment hosting the race may have stairs or other obstruction, the "door and bar facilities" may be replicated outside to achieve the same desired effect and will be the same height as a standard bar.

Please note that Operating Motorized Barstools while drinking is life-threatening and not endorsed at all.
